## **News in Brief**

DON'T FORGET Greener Pocklington are offering an opportunity to help them build a bug hotel on the amenity land off Storking Lane at 10.00 am on the 4<sup>th</sup> October. If you have any suitable material and/or want to help out with this biodiversity project, just turn up!



The Community Payback team have removed the broken post and rail fencing separating the amenity land from the beck. The wood has been stacked and if it's useful to anyone for kindling, please help yourselves. Once the Drainage Board have cleared the vegetation, the Community Payback team will return to install the new fence and replace the stone benchmark.

We have commissioned a joiner to install the dedicated children's bookcase in the foyer at the Community Centre. There's no installation date yet, but if you have children's books you were thinking of giving away, please hang on to them until the bookcase is built. Many thanks.

The landline associated with the Parish Council has been withdrawn. Please contact the Clerk via mobile/WhatsApp on the number below. Email and Facebook Messenger is also an option.

Willow Park Road – a bench will be located on the junction of Willow Park Road and Wold View Road to offer a resting place for those walking the village on foot.

Some of you may have noticed that the **Speed Indicator Device** has been moved. It is now monitoring traffic entering the village from the eastern entrance. A delivery driver was recorded doing 37 mph but was seen to slow down once the figure was flashed up.

Remedial work will be carried out to trees at **Jubilee Wood** on Ings Road shortly. The copse of trees is the responsibility of the Parish Council.


